Court records indicate you failed to appear or resolve your case by the due date. As a result, a civil assessment in the amount of \$300.00 (pursuant to Penal Code 1214.1) has been added to the amount due. In addition, a failure to appear hold has been sent to the Department of Motor Vehicles. **You must resolve your case to prevent further collection action. If the amount due is listed as "Appearance Required" you are required to appear via video conference on or before the 20<sup>th</sup> day. The Court will not recall the failure to appear hold until you do one of the following:**

1. To clear your case without appearing and to release the driver's license hold, you must pay the above amount due in full or make monthly payment arrangements no later than 20 days from the date of this notice. 2. Appear via Video Conference (Zoom):

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, an in-person court appearance is not possible at this time. You may only appear via Zoom, a free video conference application. Hearings are held Monday – Friday at 8:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Assistance is available Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

You may request to appear via video conference by utilizing one of the options below:

1. Speak with a clerk at the Virtual Public Counter via Zoom on a device with audio and video capabilities. Using the camera or QR code reader on your device, scan this QR code or enter the meeting ID 588 771 2525 in the Zoom application to enter the virtual waiting room.
2. Call and speak with a clerk at (916) 875-7800. Please note that the wait time can exceed 30 minutes.
3. Submit an email to [TrafficCustomerService@saccourt.ca.gov](mailto:TrafficCustomerService@saccourt.ca.gov), indicating your full name, citation or case number, driver's license number, and your date and time preference. You will receive an email response within 2 business days confirming that your video conference has been scheduled.



The assessment will remain on your case unless you appear via video conference within 20 days from the date on this notice and show good cause as to why you failed to appear or otherwise resolve your case as required. At the hearing, you may request community service in lieu of paying the fine. There are a variety of service assignments for all education levels and physical limitations. Flexible schedules and hours may also be available.

**Warning – Trial by Declaration:** If you fail to comply within 20 days, the court will deem your failure to appear as an election to proceed to judgment on the charge(s) with a court trial by declaration as authorized under Vehicle Code section 40903. In addition, the imposed civil assessment will become a final enforceable civil judgment and the entire amount due, plus an administrative fee, will be referred for collection.
