

You have agreed or been ordered to make monthly payments on your court fine. The Department of Revenue Recovery will process the monthly billing and payments on behalf of the Court. Failure to pay as ordered will result in your account becoming delinquent. If your account becomes delinquent, collection enforcement includes, but is not limited to, garnishment of your wages, seizure of funds from bank account(s), placement of a lien on any real property, delinquency notice to credit bureaus, seizure of your California State Income Tax Refund, or a warrant issued for your arrest. In addition, the delinquent amount may be referred to an outside collection agency and you will not be allowed to appear in court. Non-receipt of your monthly statement does not relieve you of your monthly payment obligation. At any time before your final payment, if you have experienced a change in financial circumstances, you may ask that the court consider your ability to pay at MyCitations.courts.ca.gov. If the court considers your ability to pay, the Court may modify your installment plan, allow you to complete community service instead of paying the total amount due, or suspend all or part of the fine. The court is not required to offer you any of the above options, and the court may deny your request.
